Summary of the School Financial Condition for 2019-2020

It goes without saying that 2020 has been a challenge to us all. This of course is also true of managing the school's finances during the Covid-19 crisis. School income decreased dramatically this year, despite increased enrollment and a tuition increase. Instructional and administrative costs, especially salaries, pension and health care, continue to rise. Due to Covid there's also new costs to keep the students and teachers safe. We were able to decrease the amount of spending on operational costs only by decreasing capital projects. Dare to Dream went virtual this year, only with a 5% decrease in revenue from last year. It is the school's major fundraising event, and proceeds are used to assist in the overall operation of the school.

Due to the Governmental Payroll Protection Plan loan, we finished the year with a surplus. We cannot count on such income in the future.

The school remains an important part of our parish ministry. We continue to ask that those who receive the parishioner tuition rate attend mass regularly and participate in the school/parish community at St. Benedict's. Family participation is critical to building and maintaining a close knit culture between the school and the parish. The parishioner tuition rate is the equivalent of a \$26 weekly contribution to the parish collection basket.

It is very important to recognize that in this time of shrinking church attendance and diminishing collection receipts, the school cannot depend indefinitely on a parish subsidy of any size. We continue to strive to make the school financially self-supporting.
